<u>At this time in-person pet licensing is discouraged</u> and access to our office is by appointment only. The Borough is using this format in an effort to mitigate the chance of exposure to COVID-19 as part of the Borough's ongoing effort to slow the rate of transmission. Therefore, we are encouraging licensing by mail.

Pursuant to Borough Code Chapter 146, all dog/cat licenses are renewable in January of each year. Below is the link for the application. For your convenience and safety, just fill out the application and submit necessary proof of valid rabies vaccination through November of the current year along with the required fee and postage paid envelope, and we will be happy to mail you the license and tag for your pet. Checks are payable to "South Plainfield Health Dept."
