UPDATE ON WORK IN YOUR AREA
Cornell-Dubilier Electronics Superfund Site
February 2017

This is to let you know that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) contractor will be performing drilling activities in your area during the month of February 2017. This work will be done on county roadways and private properties to determine the feasibility of installing a new waterline. Currently, a 36-inch waterline passes through the former Cornell-Dubilier Electronics facility property. This property, located at 333 Hamilton Boulevard, is part of the site. EPA has determined that the waterline needs to be replaced in order to reduce the risks associated with cleanup actions taken on the property. EPA has determined that the most feasible route for the replacement waterline includes a portion of Hamilton Boulevard and Spicer Avenue, and that there is a need for borings along these two roadways. EPA's contractor has already made contact with the public works and police departments in South Plainfield to discuss traffic control and any concerns they may have with the work. Once the work has been done on the public roadways, it will be restored to prior conditions.
