U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Cornell Dubilier Electronics Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its **Second** Five-Year Review of the Cornell Dubilier Electronics Superfund Site located in South Plainfield, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The purpose of the five-year review is to ensure that the implemented portions of the cleanup plans remain protective of public health and the environment. The remedies selected by EPA consist of 1) excavation of residential, municipal and on-site contaminated soil; 2) on-site treatment of amenable soils by low temperature thermal desorption; and 3) off-site disposal of the remaining contaminated soils. Long term monitoring of the groundwater contamination at the site is ongoing and plans to address the contaminated sediments in the Bound Brook are being developed.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determining if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized that may call into question the protectiveness of the remedy.
