April 3, 2018

The Department of Public Works has been working diligently to remove all debris from Winter Storm Quinn. Debris in roadways, on sidewalks, near schools and large debris obstructions have been removed. Beginning this Monday, April 9th cleanup efforts will be performed in accordance with the regular leaf collection schedule and district. This means starting on Monday Section #1 of the leaf collection area will have their debris removed and the process will last approximately one week. Once Section #1 is complete, Public Works employees will move to section #2 and so on. When a section is completed Public Works will NOT return to that area.

- Debris should not be put in the street.
- All branches/limbs should be no longer than six feet in length or six inches in diameter.
- All roads will be visited one time only. If brush is not by the curb when collection crews arrive, the material will not be picked up and there will not be a return collection trip.
