UPDATE ON WORK IN YOUR AREA
Cornell-Dubilier Electronics Superfund Site
March 2020

This is to let you know that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is performing the next phases of clean-up activities at the Cornell-Dubilier Electronics Superfund site. The work will begin this month with the removal of trees and vegetation adjacent to the former Cornell-Dubilier Electronics property. The excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soils and the installation of a new waterline will begin in late Spring.

This property, located at 333 Hamilton Boulevard in South Plainfield, is part of the site. EPA has found this area is contributing to the contamination found in the Bound Brook.

The EPA expects construction activities for these phases of the work to last 20 months and mostly be limited to the former Cornell property and adjacent roads. EPA and its contractors are working closely with the Borough of South Plainfield to answer any concerns about the work.
