ELECTION POLL WORKERS NEEDED

WHO CAN BE A POLL WORKER:

- You must be registered to vote in Middlesex County.
- You must be able to read and write English.
- You must have transportation to and from the polling location.
- You must attend a poll worker training class of instruction and then take a refresher course every other year.
- You must not be a candidate or a close relative of a candidate whose name appears on the ballot.

WHAT AN ELECTION POLL WORKER DOES:

- Attend a training class prior to the election every two years.
- Take a turn picking up an election bag of materials from the Municipal Clerk at Borough Hall the day before the election.
- Report to the polling location 45 minutes before the polls open.
- Prepare the polling place for voting.
- Verify that voters are registered in the district.
- Assist voters in the voting process.
- Maintain order at the polls.
- Close polling location and takes a turn at returning the election bag of results back to the Municipal Clerk at Borough Hall.
- Note: the picking up and returning of election bag materials to the Municipal Clerk will earn you an extra \$25.00
