

## PRESS RELEASE

### NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup> GENERAL ELECTION:

Due to Covid-19 the General Election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 3rd. Middlesex County is encouraging voters to vote by mail from home to promote safety while still exercising one's right to vote during this pandemic.

As such, the Borough of South Plainfield also encourages voters to vote by mail from the comfort and safety of their own home. The vote by mail ballots will come with postage paid envelopes for the ease and convenience of the voters. They must be postmarked no later than the close of the polls on election day.

Also, the County has a special ballot drop-box on order for South Plainfield, which will be located at the back entrance of Borough Hall, located at 2480 Plainfield Avenue. The exact date of delivery of the ballot drop-box is still pending. Furthermore, as another option, mail-in ballots may now be dropped off at your correct polling place location on election day only.

All usual polling locations will be open on November 3<sup>rd</sup> from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for provisional paper ballot voting ONLY. It is recommended that masks be worn in the building.

If voting in by paper ballot in-person, you must go to your usual polling location. Polling locations are as follows:
