To: South Plainfield Residents with Permits to Carry.

Please be advised that due to the implementation of the Civilian Carry Assessment and Range Evaluation (CCARE) Protocol, implemented on September 15th 2023, we are sending out this informational Email regarding the new procedure.

Since the HQC2 interim qualification training was issued on July 21st, 2023 and the new CCARE Protocol was implemented on September 15th, 2023, Law Enforcement Agencies shall provide any individuals who needs to requalify to meet the new CCARE Protocol standard, until December 31st, 2023 to do so. These individuals will have until then to meet the requirements of the new law. Failure to requalify, under N.J.S.A. 2c:58-4(g), by December 31st, 2023 will render the applicable Individual's permit to carry INVALID.

Once the CCARE Protocols are met, the individual applicant shall send a copy of the newly completed CCARE Protocol Certificate to South Plainfield Police Department for filing. (2480 Plainfield Ave. South Plainfield NJ 07080 Attn. Firearms Unit.)

If your training certificate was not issued under the new CCARE Protocol, you will need to reach out to your preferred firearms instructor to schedule the training before December 31st, 2023 to remain in compliance with the new LAW.
