Despite COVID-19, there is still a safe and secure way to exercise our right to vote in this year's primary election, currently scheduled for July 7th.

You can now apply for New Jersey's Vote By Mail initiative, allowing you to vote from the comfort of your home. Simply complete the application and return it no later than June 30, to ensure your ballot is counted in July's primary election. Additional postage is not required.
