

Borough of South Plainfield Hurricane Sandy Information Sheet

What has been done so far:

- About 80% of the power in the Borough has been restored.
- We have been in constant contact with PSE&G about getting the remaining areas up. They cannot give us a definite timeframe for restoring power to any specific areas. We have supplied PSE&G with the locations for all areas still without power.
- We have given PSE&G the locations of downed trees that are in contact with power lines. Our public works employees cannot touch these trees. PSE&G has informed us that tree crews have been deployed and will handle these trees and wires as soon as possible.
- Public Works is has been using all available equipment to collect storm debris (branches, etc.).
