

ORDINANCE 2083

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2064 PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD AND THE METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SUCH COMPENSATION FOR THE YEARS 2016 THROUGH 2018 TO NOW INCLUDE THE POSITIONS OF ENGINEERING, RECYCLING, ENVIRONMENTAL, CULTURAL ARTS, AND TRAFFIC SAFETY SECRETARIES AND AMEND COMMUNITY SERVICE WORKER – AGING SALARY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South Plainfield, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The rates of compensation for each employee of the Borough of South Plainfield shall be on an annual basis as follows except where indicated. Such rates of pay shall be effective on January 1st of the years shown.
