

**ORDINANCE NO. 2091**

**A SEWER CAPITAL ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE “ACQUISITION OF A PUMPING STATION ALARM SYSTEM AT 4 PUMPING STATIONS AND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A GRINDER AT THE HADLEY ROAD PUMPING STATION FOR THE SEWER UTILITY, IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD, NEW JERSEY** as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned assets be funded by existing funds in the Capital Improvement Funds in the Sewer Utility. The funding requirements shall be identified by asset as follows:

Pumping Station Alarm System	<b>\$17,000.00</b>
Grinder/Muncher Hadley Station	<b>\$49,000.00</b>
<b>Totals</b>	<b><u>\$66,000.00</u></b>

Section 2. That the improvements described in Section 1 hereof shall be authorized as Sewer Capital Improvements for the Borough of South Plainfield in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and declared by this Mayor and Borough Council as follows:

- A. That the maximum estimated amount of money to be raised from all sources for the purposes stated in Section 1, hereof, is \$66,000.00.
- B. That the cost for the equipment shall be \$66,000 from the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund.
- C. The estimated useful life of said improvements is hereby determined to be five (5) years.

Section 4. That the total amount of the appropriation to be expended for Architectural and inspection costs, legal costs, advertisement of ordinance and other expenses as provided in Section 48:2-20 of the Revised Statutes, is not to exceed \$1,000.00.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
