

**Minutes from the February 6, 2012 Special Public Hearing  
of the South Plainfield Mayor and Council on the  
2012 Housing & Community Development Block Grant**

The meeting was called to order at 6:45pm by Mayor Anesh in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6.

Present: Mayor Anesh, Council members Barletta, Bengivenga, Frank, McConville, Rusnak, White, Administrator/CFO Glenn Cullen, Municipal Clerk Joann Graf, Borough Attorney Paul Rizzo, and Borough Engineer Len Miller.

Councilman Bengivenga gave a brief introduction on the HCD Grant process and the purpose of the public hearing and gave a preliminary list of suggested uses which the HCD Committee will include in their consideration of possible projects for 2012. These include:

Senior Citizen Coordinator salary	\$12,500
Senior Citizen Auditorium lighting upgrade	\$20,000
Continue ADA Ramp installation program	\$40,000
Upgrade the front entrance of Borough Hall to ADA accessible	<u>\$15,000</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$87,500</b>

Mr. Rusnak commented on the lighting upgrade at the Senior Center saying that this is a worthwhile project that will enhance the atmosphere of the auditorium for social events.

Mayor Anesh clarified the proposal to upgrade the front entrance of Borough Hall comparing it to the ADA accessible back door and also mentioned the possibility of a vestibule being added.

Mayor Anesh opened the hearing for public comment. There were no comments offered by the public so the public hearing was closed.

A resolution will be prepared for the Feb. 21, 2012 Council meeting authorizing the list of proposed projects and dollar amounts.

Having no further public comment, Mayor Anesh called for a motion to adjourn. So moved by Mr. Barletta and seconded by Mr. Rusnak. The meeting adjourned at 6:55pm.
