Councilman McConville - was absent this evening.

<u>Council President Rusnak</u> – reported that the tax bills were mailed out last week and the next payment coming due is for November 1^{st} . Our contact information is on the tax bills if anyone has any questions. Mr. Rusnak said that at the last meeting we had some residents who expressed their concerns regarding some property maintenance issues they were experiencing with a home on their street. Since then we were able to make contact with the bank who sent someone out right away to clean up the property. They did promise to keep up with it. To conclude, Mr. Rusnak said he believes the new K-9 dogs will be introduced at our next Council meeting. Chief Parker, who was in the audience, confirmed that they may be ready to announce the names of the dogs at the next meeting and acknowledge the students who picked out the names.

<u>Mayor Anesh</u> – reported that October 3^{rd} is walk to school day. The rain date will the October 4^{th} . The second annual health fair will be held on October 13th at the Senior Center and everyone is encouraged to come out. There will be free flu shots given out to the first 75 residents. Mayor Anesh concluded by advising that he will be attending a Mayor's Roundtable Meeting at the Governor's mansion and if anyone has any concerns or issues that they would like to have expressed at this meeting to let him know.

Nancy Grennier advised that tickets are on sale for Taste of South Plainfield. October 17th will be the annual local debates in which everyone is invited to attend. Also meet the candidates for the school board is forthcoming. To conclude, the South Plainfield Business Association will be sponsoring a food drive at the entrance to the polling places during the November election.
