<u>Review of Agenda Items</u>: Clerk Antonides reviewed all the items on the agenda for this evening. Mayor Anesh asked if the Council has any comments on the agenda this evening.

Councilman Diana asked to have resolution 13-211 separated out for him. Councilman Diana then asked Mr. Cullen to advise him which of the resolutions on this evening's agenda are covered under a bonding ordinance. Mr. Cullen advised 13-212, 13-216, 13-217, 13-219, 13-224, and 13-226. Councilman Diana said he would like to separate all these resolutions to vote on individually.

Councilman Barletta asked Mr. Miller if he reviewed 13-227 and if it is ok for the applicant to put the requested fence in this right of way? Mr. Miller said yes he has reviewed it and does not see any problems with the installation of this fence.

Councilman McConville said that regarding resolution 13-212 he recalls former council members and Mayors discussing that we do have money put aside for this site remediation. Councilman McConville said that seeing this on the agenda he guesses that we do not have money put aside for this. Mayor Anesh said that is correct and apparently what he had heard is wrong. Councilman Bengivenga said that the first part of the remediation was done through a state grant, but now, the state grant is no longer available. We have no choice now but to bond for it to finish out the clean-up. Councilman McConville expressed his shock that we have to pay for this now as we were told several years back that we would not have to pay a dime for it. Mayor Anesh said the problem is when the property was sold there was a hold harmless agreement that was not brought before Council and was executed by the Mayor at the time, and were told that all clean-up for the site would be paid for handled by state grants. But since the state will not grant any more money in this regard, we are now stuck with \$290,000.00 to finish this clean-up.

There were no further comments from the Council on the agenda.
