

Dear Residents:

February 8, 2013

This is Mayor Anesh with an important message regarding today's snow storm. The National Weather service has issued a winter storm warning for South Plainfield beginning 3:00pm this afternoon until 6:00am Saturday morning. This is a very dangerous storm, and I urge all residents to use caution if venturing outside.

This evening the combination of heavy snow and strong winds are expected to generate near blizzard conditions. I am declaring a Snow Emergency for 8:00pm this evening until 9:00am tomorrow morning. Starting 8:00pm tonight I request only emergency personnel should be using Borough roadways. Residents are urged to stay home safe with their families. The high winds and snow may cause power outages, so be prepared for the storm.

I ask all residents to move parked vehicles from roads so plows can clear as much snow from the streets as possible. The Department of Public Works will be plowing throughout the night. If you live on a snow emergency route you are required to remove your vehicle.

The PAL building will be closing today at 5:00pm and all recreational activities at the PAL tomorrow, 2/9/13, are cancelled.

Once again, I ask that all residents remain vigilant and safe during this storm. If you lose power and operate a gas generator, remember gas generator should not be operated indoors. Gas power generators throw off poisonous carbon monoxide gas which is lethal. I encourage residents to visit our Facebook page and website for continuous updates regarding the storm.
