ADOPT-A-SPOT PROGRAM

The South Plainfield Clean Communities Association was formed to promote a more attrac-tive business environment. The Adopt-A-Spot community involvement program brings together business leaders and the borough in a partnership designed to create a litter-free community.

The Adopt-A-Spot Program is open to any South Plainfield business that is a Clean Business Association member. In adopting a spot, the business commits to a periodic clean-up and maintenance schedule. Signs will be posted at the spot recognizing the sponsor's contributions to a cleaner community.

ADOPT-A-SPOT

Maintenance Guidelines

- Under the Adopt-A-Spot program, a business agrees to cleanup and maintain an area it has adopted.
- 1. The sponsor maintains the adopted site for a one year period.
- 2. Maintenance includes picking up litter and debris from the site. Also, mowing grass, weeding, planting flowers or related activities may be undertaken.
- 3. Established safety procedures must be followed.
- 4. The sponsor must provide a certificate of insurance showing comprehensive general liability insurance coverage before initiating the program.
- 5. The Clean Communities Association provides trash bags for bagging litter and debris. Arrangements will be made for collection of the litter.
- 6. The Clean Business Association provides two Adopt-A-Spot signs designating the sponsor's name.
