



## HOW TO FIND THE OWNER OF LOST DOGS & CATS

It starts with the pet owner.

Being a pet owner requires all sorts of responsibility. Upon licensing your dog or cat annually at Borough Hall as required by state law and local ordinance, you are to place the pet tag on the collar of your beloved pet. A license tag helps police, animal control, shelters, and good samaritans to quickly identify your dog or cat and get them back to you safely. If your dog or cat is found wandering the streets, a rescue entity can easily look up your dog or cat via its license identifying number by contacting South Plainfield's Municipal Clerk/Health Office or the Police Department.

If you have not yet licensed your dog or cat, please do so as soon as possible, and please put the annual pet license tag on the collar of your dog or cat! It may save their life.
