REGISTER READY - For Individuals With Disabilities Who May Need Assistance In A Disaster

South Plainfield Residents can now go on the South Plainfield Borough website – www.southplainfieldnj.org, to access a link to register for individuals who may need assistance in a disaster. The link is www.registerready.nj.gov.

What is Register Ready? Register Ready is a free, secure, voluntary database design to help emergency managers and first responders plan for and support people with disabilities and access and functional needs (DAFN) who may need assistance in the event of a disaster.

You (or someone on your behalf) are encouraged to register if you have a physical, developmental, cognitive or behavioral impairment, language barrier, or transportation challenge that may make it difficult for you to safely shelter in a place or evacuate in a disaster.

Who Should Register? Permanent and seasonal residents with DAFN who may need help evacuating, sheltering in place or at a public shelter, or requiring emergency assistance should register. Individuals with a temporary disability, such as high-risk pregnancy or other serious medical condition, should register.
