- The Labor Day Festivities will be held on Monday, September 3rd, 2012. There is no rain date.
- Please return a completed vendor application and your donation as indicated above, to the attention of Debbie Leporino,
 c/o the PUBLIC CELEBRATIONS COMMITTEE, Borough Hall 2480 Plainfield Avenue, South Plainfield, New Jersey,
 07080. There will be <u>no</u> cash transactions accepted the morning of the parade and festivities.
- If your applicable donation and completed application is not received by Friday, August 17th, 2012, the donation is increased by \$50.00 along with the completed application and appropriate paperwork. The completed application <u>must be received</u> prior to the above date or you will not be permitted to take part in the Labor Day Festivities.
- Any vendors who have food <u>must</u> register with the Board of Health and Fire Inspector (if applicable) before Friday, August 17th, 2012, and are to present the appropriate paperwork the morning of the festivities.
- If you are using an open flame and/or flammable product, you <u>must</u> register with the South Plainfield Fire Inspector no later than Friday, August 17th, 2012, and are to present this paperwork the morning of the festivities. Go to <u>www.southplainfieldfire.com</u>, click on "downloads", then click on "Fire Permits" to download the Fire Permits' application with instructions and then mail it with your check for \$42.00 to 123 Maple Avenue, South Plainfield, New Jersey, 07080, Attn: Fire Inspector. Please call 908-756-4761 for any other information or you may need.
- Once the application is completed, please mail it to the attention of Debbie Leporino, in c/o the Borough address above no later than Friday, August 17th, 2012. It is important that you complete this application as any vendors who arrive on the morning of the festivities without a completed application will not be permitted to participate in the festivities. The completed vendor application reserves you a designated spot to set up at the South Plainfield Middle School.
- Only one (1) vehicle per vendor is permitted for set up prior to the festivities and vendors are to provide their own tents, tables, chairs, etc. Absolutely <u>no</u> vehicles are allowed on the Middle School lawn or sidewalk area on the morning of the festivities.
- On the morning of the festivities, please arrive at the Middle School parking lot between 7:00 and 7:30 as the roads will be closed shortly thereafter. You <u>must</u> check in by presenting the following paperwork:
- 1. Proof of registration with the Board of Health (food vendors) and Fire Inspector (if applicable)
- Photocopy of donation check and application
- Only after check-in, you may unload your vehicle by driving up to the curb, parking and offloading. After offloading, you
 may park in the designated parking area.
- There will be no smoking, whatsoever, on the Middle School property and/or any BOE property surrounding the South Plainfield Middle School property.

- Street Vendors —These vendors are for participation in the Labor Day Parade only. Please report to Borough Hall to register prior to the start of the parade and note that your participation in the parade does not include participation at the Middle School festivities as this is a separate vendor and application process (above).
