

ORDINANCE 2322**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 2225 AND 2157 THAT PROVIDES FOR THE COMPENSATION OF PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FOR THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD FOR THE YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2028**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South Plainfield, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The rates of compensation for each part-time employee of the Borough of South Plainfield shall be on an hourly basis as follows. Such rates of pay shall be effective on 10/1/2024 unless otherwise noted.
