AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2322, 2225 and 2157 THAT					
THAT PROVIDES FOR THE COMPENSATION OF					
PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FOR THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD					
FOR THE YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2028					
BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of South Plainfield, County of Middlesex,					
State of New Jersey as follows:					
SECTION 1: The rates of compensation for each part-time employee of the Borough of South Plainfield shall be					
on an hourly basis as follows. Such rates of pay shall be effective on 1/1/2024					
unless otherwise noted.
