

ORDINANCE 2334

A CAPITAL ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDING A NEW ROOF AT THE SOUTH PLAINFIELD SENIOR CENTER LOCATED AT 90 MAPLE AVENUE, IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH PLAINFIELD, NEW JERSEY as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned assets shall be funded by a 2024/2025 Middlesex County CDBG Grant and funding from the Borough of South Plainfield. The funding requirements shall be identified by said asset as follows:

Middlesex County CDBG	\$127,800.00
Capital Improvement Fund	50,000.00
Capital Fund Balance	<u>50,000.00</u>
 Totals	 <u>\$227,800.00</u>

Section 2. That the improvements described in Section 1 hereof shall be authorized as Capital Improvements for the Borough of South Plainfield in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and declared by this Mayor and Borough Council as follows:

- A. That the maximum estimated amount of money to be raised from all sources for the purposes stated in Section 1, hereof, is \$227,800.00.
- B. That the cost for the Capital Improvements shall be \$127,800 from a CDBG Grant, \$50,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund and \$50,000 from Capital Fund Balance.
- C. The estimated useful life of said improvements is hereby determined to be ten (10) years.

Section 4. That the total amount of the appropriation to be expended for Architectural and inspection costs, legal costs, advertisement of ordinance and other expenses as provided in Section 48:2-20 of the Revised Statutes, is not to exceed \$10,000.00.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
